The new series *Studien zur Rechtstheorie* reflects the research on interdisciplinary legal theory conducted at the Max Planck Institute for Legal History and Theory since 2021. In terms of concept, layout, and equipment, it is based on the Institute's legal history series, *Studien zur europäischen Rechtsgeschichte*, which has been published since 1971.

The new series *Studien zur Rechtstheorie* begins auspiciously with the edition of previously unpublished early writings by one of the most important European legal philosophers and committed intellectuals of the 20th century: Norberto Bobbio (1909–2004), who was considered the civic and secular conscience of republican Italy. Known in Germany not least for his publications on questions of constitutional law and basic problems of political economy, his two dissertations, which marked the beginning of his academic career, were long unavailable to the scientific public. Bobbio's studies on the philosophy and dogmatics of law and on Edmund Husserl's phenomenology, written in the early 1930s, are now available in an annotated edition of the Italian originals, philologically prepared by his student Mario G. Losano and provided with a thorough introduction and helpful indexes.
